## **Itinerary Overview (Ontario - Moncton)**

### **Day 1 – Whitby, Ontario to Ottawa, Ontario**

**Departure Point "A" (8:45 am):** Consumers Dr. Whitby (across from Holiday Inn)

**Pit Stop "B" (10:00-10:45 am):** Havelock, Ontario – Gas / Coffee

**Pickup Point "C" (11:45-12:00 pm):** Hwy 7 / Hwy 41, Kaladar

**Lunch Stop "D" (1:00-2:30 pm):** Perth Curling Club 33 Beckwith St. Perth

**Overnight Stop "E":** Host Hotel - Holiday Inn Express, 2881 Gibford Dr. Ottawa

**Evening Activity (6:00 pm >):** A&W, NW corner of Merivale & Hunt Club Rds.

### **Day 2 - Ottawa, Ontario to Riviere-du-Loup, Quebec**

**Departure Point "A" (7:30 am):** Holiday Inn Express, 2881 Gibford Dr. Ottawa

**Pit Stop "B" (8:45-9:00 am):** Cornwall, Ontario – Fifth Wheel, McConnell Ave.

**Pit Stop "C" (10:15-11:00 pm):** A&W Chateaugay, Quebec, 72 Boulevard Saint-Jean-Baptiste

**Lunch Stop/Shop Tour "D" (11:15-12:30 pm):** CCR Technologie, Delson Quebec, 300 St-François-Xavier

**Pit Stop "E" (3:00–3:45 pm):** A&W Levis, Quebec, 108, route du Président Kennedy

**Overnight Stop "F":** Host Hotel - Auberge de la Pointe, 10 boulevard Cartier, Rivière-du-Loup

**Evening Activity:** Chill out after a long day

### **Day 3 – Riviere-du-Loup, Quebec to Miramichi, New Brunswick**

\*\* Note: We lose 1 hour entering New Brunswick hence the early start \*\*

**Departure Point "A" (7:00 am):** Auberge de la Pointe, 10 boulevard Cartier

**Pit Stop "B" (9:30-9:45 am):** St. Leonard, New Brunswick

**Pit Stop "C" (11:15-12:00 pm):** A&W Atholville/Campbellton, New Brunswick

**Lunch Stop "D" (1:00-2:30 pm):** Bathurst, New Brunswick, K.C. Irving Reg. Centre, 850 St. Anne St.

\*\*Note: Before proceeding to the hotel in Miramichi, we will stop at the Rock & Roll Festival Show & Shine in Newcastle as Guests of Honour (arrival ~ 3:20) \*\*

**Overnight Stop "E":** Host Hotel – Rodd Miramichi, 1809 Water St. Miramichi, NB

**Evening Activity:** Meet & Greet – In adjacent Newcastle

#### **Day 4 – Miramichi, New Brunswick to Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island**

\*\* Note: Departure point is not the host hotel \*\*

**Departure Point “A” (7:30-8:30 am):** A&W Miramichi, 102 Douglastown Blvd (north of river, first street east of Hwy 11 north off King George Hwy.

**Pit Stop “B” (10:00-10:45 am):** Shediac, Nova Scotia

**Location “C” (11:45-12:45 pm):** PEI South shore Hwy 1 / Hwy 10 (Possible rendezvous point). Continue drive to Point “D”.

**Overnight Stop “D”:** **Host Hotel:** Rodd Confederation / Royalty Inns, 20 Capital Dr. (Hwy 1 just before University Ave. on right side)

\*\*Note: Lunch at your discretion at local restaurants on University Ave. You can buy a bridge pass at the Irving located at 644 University Ave. just around the corner from the Rodd Hotel(s). The cost of the return trip is \$42.50 (plus \$7 for each additional axle over 2). See next two items for afternoon and evening activities\*\*

**Departure Point “A” (7:30-8:30 am):** A&W, 650 University Ave, Charlottetown

**Pit Stop “B” (10:00-10:45 am):** A&W Amherst, 219 Albion St. S, Amherst NS

**Lunch Stop “C” (12:15-1:45 pm):** A&W New Glasgow/Stellarton, 124 North Foord Street, Stellarton NS

**Pit Stop “D” (2:45-3:10 pm):** Irving Big Stop, Hwy 4/Hwy 104/Hwy 4/Sunrise Trail, Auld Cove NS

**Overnight Stop “E”:** Host Hotel – North Star Inn, 39 Forrest Street, North Sydney, NS

**Evening Activity:** Free evening

**Location “D” (11:00-12:30 pm):** Neils Harbour

**Location “E” (1:00-1:30 pm):** Ingonish Beach (some restaurants noted below)

\*\* Note: Atlantic @ Keltic Lodge, Coastal Waters, Crofters/Thirsty Hiker’s @ Glenghorm\*\*

**Location “F” (3:00-4:15 pm):** North Gut / St. Ann’s

### **Day 7 – North Sydney, Nova Scotia to Dartmouth, Nova Scotia**

**Departure Point “A” (8:30 am):** North Star Inn, 39 Forrest Street, North Sydney, NS

**Pit Stop “B” (10:30-11:15 am):** Henry’s Esso at Hwy 104 / 316 on right side ~ 7 kms. before Antigonish, NS

**Lunch Stop “C” (12:30-2:00 pm):** A&W Truro, NS 138 Robie St.

**Overnight Stop “D”:** Host Hotel – Quality Inn Mic Mac, 313 Prince Albert Rd, Dartmouth

**Evening Activity (6:00>):** A&W Dartmouth, 370 Pleasant St.

**Directions:** Go right on Hwy 7 across from hotel to “Circumferential Hwy” 111, right on 111 southeast to Pleasant St. Turn right on to Pleasant, restaurant is just ahead on left side.
